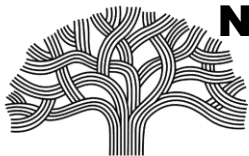


# 99<sup>th</sup> Oakland City Amateur Golf Championship

## NCGA Championship/Senior Championship point event



Lake Chabot Golf Course

### Conditions of Competition

#### 1. GENERAL

**a. Governance:** The Lake Chabot Golf Course will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the United States Golf Association (USGA) effective January 1, 2012.

**b. The Host Professional:** The event will be conducted under the direction of the General Manager of the golf course. The General Manager will be responsible for all interpretations and rulings on the conduct of the event and such rulings shall be final. A rules committee will also be formed to assist in interpretation of rule(s) but final say will be by General Manager.

**c. Scoring:** Each player shall be issued an official scorecard for the event and shall return same to Scorer upon completion of their round. Each player must enter an actual score on each hole as per USGA guidelines. Scoring will be based on total low GROSS for 36 holes for the Championship and Senior Championship flights and total low NET for all other flights. All scores must be attested by a fellow competitor and/or the Golf Professional Staff at the qualifying facility. **(Lake Chabot Golf Course Tournament Committee will post both days scores to the given GHIN number for competition. DO NOT post your own scores for the tournament).**

**d. Handicaps:** Championship and Senior Championship participants will use no handicap. The maximum allowable course handicap is 36 for each player in the NET Flights. Each participant will be required to have a valid verifiable USGA (or other recognized handicap, issued by a regional or state handicap organization and following USGA guidelines). Official handicaps for the event will be determined using the player's lowest current Index and the slope rating of the course being played as outlined in the USGA Handicap Manual, Section 10-4. All participants in NET flights will receive 90% of their adjusted course handicap.

**e. Tees Played:** The Championship Flight will play from the BLUE tees. The Senior Championship Flight will play from the WHITE tees. Participants in the NET Flights will play from the WHITE tees.

**f. Playoff Procedure:** Sudden death playoffs will occur to determine the first place winner in all flights, beginning on Hole #1. All other ties will be broken using the USGA scorecard tiebreaking procedures for prize distribution only. See section (g) below for NCGA Points Distribution.

**g. NCGA Points Distribution:** For the Championship and Senior Championship Flights, the points will be determined based on the final player count – players will be notified how many points the competition will have before the first playday May 1st. The NCGA will add and split all points for ties other than for first place. All split points will be rounded up.

**h. Disqualification:** Participants found violating USGA rules, tournament rules, falsifying or neglecting handicaps or otherwise engaging in conduct inconsistent with the tournament standards or spirit of fair play may be disqualified without claim or recourse of any type.

**2. Amateur Status:** The Oakland City Championship is open ONLY to amateur golfers as defined by the United States Golf Association (USGA).
